

# CÔTES DE BORDEAUX

## 2014 & 2015

Fruit-forward, unfussy, hugely drinkable wines are what the Côtes de Bordeaux specialise in. This is Bordeaux at its most authentic and good value. The Côtes draws together wines made from five separate areas of Blaye, Cadillac, Castillon, Francs and Sainte-Foy that lie on the Right Bank of Bordeaux along the Dordogne and Garonne rivers. They count around 950 winegrowers between them, making around 10% of Bordeaux's total output per year. And they are largely family-run properties that prioritise not only making delicious wines, but welcoming visitors to discover what are some of the most beautiful parts of Bordeaux.

The Côtes, like most of the Bordeaux region, is a largely red wine area (around 97% of the total production) from the Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes – sometimes with small additions of more unusual varieties such as Malbec. There are also some excellent white wines, made primarily from the Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon grapes and sometimes Sauvignon Gris or Muscadelle.

These are richly textured and interesting wines that have a story to tell, so it's always worth looking at the back label, visiting the website, or heading out to Bordeaux to visit. There are excellent Maisons des Vins in the Côtes that offer regular tastings and stock the vast majority of the wines selected here.

The Bordeaux region as a whole is experiencing a renaissance in wine tourism, with around five million visitors per year, and the Côtes offer some of its most enriching and exhilarating experiences. They contain some of the oldest châteaux

in Bordeaux, some dating back to the 12th century and earlier. There are Roman remains to be found around the city of Blaye, along with a UNESCO World Heritage Citadelle overlooking the Gironde Estuary. Cadillac (where Musée de la Vigne et du Vin was awarded International Best of Wine Tourism) and Francs are full of historic châteaux and ancient churches that date back to the Middle Ages. Castillon (where the Hundred Years War ended), and Sainte-Foy are full of rolling countryside as they head towards the Dordogne, with towering limestone hills that offer perfect bedrock for vines, and plenty of spots for canoeing along the Dordogne river. The Côtes de Bordeaux areas offer wine festivals that are held all year-round. There are marathons, hikes and various events where winemakers share their passion and know-how with visitors.

The 2014 and 2015 vintages that we are tasting here are part of a trilogy of good quality years in Bordeaux – with 2016 bringing

up the rear and proving the third good year in a row, of which we have just one or two white wines listed, as the reds need just a few more months before bottling.

But the two vintages chosen here give you plenty of choice for quality wine. In style, 2014 is a little more structured and classic, and 2015 luscious and sexy. For the Right Bank in particular, where the Côtes de Bordeaux are based, 2015 was particularly excellent, and a lot of great drinking wines didn't make it into the final selection simply because I tasted well over 200 wines, and there was only room for around half of that number here.

Also worth noting that for the first time the appellation of Sainte-Foy Bordeaux is included in the tasting. The area is not officially part of the Côtes de Bordeaux family until the 2016 vintage, but we are including them here as from now on they are part of the same group – and share the same spirit of making great value wines for sharing with friends.
